From Fr. Roger:



Holy Well Glass is now entering the home stretch in making improvements to



our windows and masonry surrounds. One half of the scaffolding inside the church has already been removed and the rest is due to be dismantled on 14th June; this is a couple of weeks later than was planned due to additional work identified regarding metal and masonry deterioration when removing some of the windows back to their

workshops in Wells, Somerset.

Nave roof: C J Charles Contractors have now completed the repairs to the Nave roof and any leaks appear to have been plugged; so no more buckets or umbrellas required!





At the moment the group meets each Thursday morning in the Church Room at 10.00 am so just come along, or contact Carole on 01295 811134 for more information.




TOWER BELL RINGERS WANTED
