ROOF UPDATE

The progress on this is necessarily slow. The two damaged parts of the roof have now been covered with temporary coverings so that the building is again water-tight, which is safeguarding the interior. At the moment quotes are being requested for the remedial work. The insurance company will give a contribution which will, however, cover only part of the cost of the repairs. It is expected that there will have to be an appeal launched to fund this unexpected expense. If you feel that you can help, please contact either of the churchwardens. There will be more on this in future newsletters.

If you cast your eyes upwards, you will see around the church various patterned 'squares' in the middle of the roof beams. These are called 'bosses' – and they look small where they are, but in reality measure up to 3ft square. Most are reminders of saints. In brief: 1. M for Mary, together with an R for Regina – to indicate that Mary is known as 'Queen of heaven'. 2. R - for Rumbold 3. The coat of arms of the Peterborough Diocese, showing the keys of St. Peter (one of

our patron saints). 4. The coat of arms of Thomas á Becket, Archbishop of Canterbury, who is rumoured to have prayed here en route to Northampton in 1164. The last roof boss is a bit of a mystery! Perhaps it was in the tradition of a green man, or was there a carpenter with a sense of humour..... Why not see if you can find them all when you are next in church.
